

Clearmount School  
Suggested Supplies - Grade 1

1. One package (10-20) #2 pencils to last the entire year.
2. Round tipped scissors (Fiskar scissors for children are recommended)
3. 4 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons (NO NAMES ON BOXES). Your child will be issued a new box of crayons each 9 weeks grading period.
4. One large box of tissues
5. 3 two-pocket plastic folders: 1-red, 1-yellow, 1-green. Put student's full name on front of each folder.
6. 1 box of baby wipes  
Note: Please check label. Wipes must be non-toxic and have no warning labels. Avoid kitchen, bathroom or disinfectant wipes.
7. 4 dry erase markers (Expo Brand or low odor)
8. 1 three ring binder with 2 inch rings. Put student's full name on the binder.
9. 4 LARGE glue sticks. (Elmer's preferred) Glue sticks will be issued as needed throughout the year.
10. 2 erasers
11. 1 single subject wide ruled spiral notebook. Put student's full name on the notebook.

Notes:

1. No rolling or large backpacks. Backpacks must fit in lockers.
2. Sharpen some pencils before bringing to school.
