

## HOW TO HAVE "TRADITIONAL" PRINTS MADE FROM YOUR DIGITAL PHOTOS

### **Can I develop pictures taken with my digital camera?**

Yes. You can get your digital photos developed in the same familiar manner as you do your film.

### **Can't I print digital pictures that will look just as good at home or school for free?**

There are high quality home printers that can give you great homemade prints, but if you consider the cost of ink cartridges, as well as the cost of premium paper, and the investment in buying the printer, you'll see that it's hardly "free."

### **Does it take long to develop digital pictures?**

Most often, you'll find it's the equivalent of developing film.

### **Is it more complicated to print digital pictures?**

Not at all. You can just drop off your memory card (picture card, CD, floppy disk, etc.) at a local store or one-hour lab, exactly like a roll of film. You can also use the Aladdin Digital Photo Center kiosk, Printpix DigiCam Picture Center kiosk, or Kodak Picture Maker kiosk for creativity and control or pictures in minutes at various locations.

## SOME LOCAL OPTIONS

### ***WAL-MART***

There are several ways to get professional quality prints from your digital pictures at Wal-Mart.

#### FUJIFILM PROCESSING

#### The "Drop Off Solution"

1. Bring your digital camera's memory card, CD, or floppy disk filled with your pictures to Wal-Mart's One-Hour Lab.
2. Leave your digital picture memory card CD or floppy disk with photo professionals. (Preview your files ahead of time and give the clerk a list of the files names/numbers that you wish to have

developed if you don't want prints from all files located on your digital media.) Come back one hour later for your professionally printed pictures, just like you would with film.

3. The cost is \$.25 per 4x6 photo.

### Creativity and Convenience

1. Take your digital pictures to a participating local store where the Fujifilm Aladdin kiosk can be found.
2. Use the Aladdin to add borders, add color, crop pictures, and rotate shots. (You can choose which picture you want to use from your media onscreen. For example, if your disk or memory stick contains 50 photos you can choose to print all 50 photos...1 photo...or any number in between the two.) Then choose the size and number of prints.
3. Place your order, take your digital media with you, and come back one hour later for your Fujifilm pictures.
4. The cost is \$.25 per 4x6 photo.

### KODAK PICTURE MAKER

1. The Kodak Picture Maker let's you print pictures from a variety of digital sources, including Picture CD, floppy disk and digital camera card. The one at Wal-Mart on the Strip does not accept a memory card, but newer models at some other stores will.
2. The Kodak Picture Maker allows you to crop, enlarge, zoom, make multiples, restore color, add borders and text, etc.
3. Pictures print in 27 seconds.
4. The cost is \$.48 per 4x6 photo.

## **SAM'S CLUB**

Sam's Club offers the same Fujifilm services as Wal-Mart. Turn around time is the same (one hour)...but the cost is \$.20 per 4x6 photo! Worth investigating if you have a Sam's Club membership.

## **VAN'S CAMERA**

Van's charges \$.49 per 4x6 photo. If you are a Van's Club member (\$15 membership fee per year) the charge is \$.39 per 4x6 photo.

### **INTERNET/MAIL ORDER OPTIONS**

Upload your digital photos, receive prints via mail, and share your photos with family and friends around the world without leaving your chair! You can invite anyone with Internet access to view your online albums and order prints for themselves. This is a great way to share photos from special classroom memories with your students' families and friends who may wish to have their own copies of your photos. There are literally hundreds of online services available today. The following are among the top rated:
